



#### The 2016 Loss in Perspective

\$124,302 corresponds to a little over 1/2 day of sales less than 2/10<sup>th</sup> of a penny for every \$1.00 dollar of sales.

\$124,302 loss can be compared to: \$1,019,117 fees paid for credit card services in 2016 \$936,634 in equipment costs in 2016 \$450,000 member discounts given in 2016.
