PURCHASE SHARES OF CAPITAL STOCK

Membership in the Co-op requires ownership of ten (10) shares of stock. Only members are eligible for membership privileges, including voting and member benefits. If you purchase fewer than ten shares at the time of enrollment, you will be a "subscriber" and will not be eligible for membership privileges until you own ten shares. The Co-op's bylaws require all subscribers to reach membership status within three (3) years of application for membership. If a subscriber does not own the required ten shares within three years of enrollment, the Co-op will close the application for membership and retain any value of any shares held by the subscriber. *Patronage refutures are not common so we suggest not relying on them, especially for membership shares.

Zero/Partial Investment: *I will purchase ten (10) shares within three (3) years to reach membership status.
